'UK Makes Ping Pong History'

The most significant change to the game in over 100 years - 'three-a-side Ping Pong'

Invented in the 1880s as an after dinner parlour game in England, ping pong went on to become an Olympic sport in 1998 and now it sees its first revolution, **T3 three-a-side table tennis**. 3 players per team compete at a round table!

Launched in London last year by T3 Ping Pong who designed and manufacture the tables here in the UK, the table will again make history this July, with a concrete version being installed by the City of London at Parliament Hill Fields free for all to try.

Six of the UK's top players will form two teams to compete at the table showing off their amazing table tennis skills.

The table will unveiled at the Olympic legacy sporting event, 'Give it a Go' on **Sunday 20th July 1.30pm – 5.30pm**. In previous years the event has attracted over 10,000 attendees, where all sports on the day are free to 'Give it a Go'
